Assignment Title: Technical Assistance for Aferida II and capacity building activities for assessment staff

- The Government of Cabo Verde has received from the International Development Association – IDA / World Bank (hereafter named "World Bank"), the Credit ref. 70780 to fund the Cabo Verde Human Capital Project aims to assist the Ministry of Education in the management and coordination of the implementation of the National Plan for Teacher Training - Horizon 2020/30, and intends to apply part of the amount of said credit for: Technical Assistance for Aferida II and capacity building activities for assessment staff
- 2. The Consulting Services ("the Services") aims to engage an international technical assistance in the specialty of External Assessment of Learning to support the Ministry of Education of Cabo Verde in the preparation of the Benchmarked Assessment 2023, particularly in the training of national technical teams, preparation of assessment instruments and preparation of final reports of the assessment and pedagogical intervention.

With the technical assistance (TA), the Ministry of Education also intends to contribute to the development of the capacities of the national teams involved in the assessment, to carry out similar assessments in the future, and to define an implementation methodology for the external assessment of learning, specifically in the application of benchmarked tests, in the 2022/2023 school year, in the 2nd and 6th grades of basic education.

The services are to be provided by a specialized firm, working under the direct supervision of the National Directorate for Education (DNE). The consultant will be based in Cabo Verde. The duration of the assignment will be 10 months.

 - iv. Specific experience in countries with similar conditions or context of Cabo Verde;
 - v. The technical and managerial capability of the firm.
