QUESTION N° 1: Item 5 – Language: "The language of the quotation is: English. Supporting documents may be submitted in another language, provided that the essential parts relevant for evaluation are translated into English."

We kindly request clarification on what should be considered as "supporting documents" and which are deemed the "essential parts relevant for evaluation".

ANSWER N°.1: For the purpose of this RFQ, "supporting documents" are those submitted with the quotation to demonstrate the bidder's qualification and technical compliance. Please consult Item 15 (Information on the qualification) and Item 16 (Evaluation criteria of quotation) of the RFQ for the requirements that will be considered during the evaluation.

QUESTION Nº 2: *Information on the qualification:*

QUESTION N° 2.a: "Be legally registered to supply veterinary products"

Companies that are legally authorized to trade pharmaceutical products and duly licensed by the Regulatory Authority to import, store, and distribute medicines for human use: do they require additional, specific authorization to carry out activities related to veterinary medicines and products?

If so, we kindly request an indication of the authorizations required for this purpose.

ANSWER N°. 2. a: Suppliers must be legally registered and duly authorized to supply the veterinary products specifically requested under this RFQ. All relevant licenses and authorizations required for the importation, storage, and distribution of veterinary medicines must be submitted as part of the bid documentation.

QUESTION N° 2.b: "Submit manufacturer's authorization or equivalent document for the products offered, when applicable."

We would like to confirm whether, in addition to the product technical data sheets, any other document is required from the manufacturer. If so, please specify which document(s) or which relevant information must be included.

ANSWER N°. 2.b: In accordance with Item 6 of the RFQ, bidders are required to submit the manufacturer's authorization or an equivalent document for the products offered, where applicable, together with the product technical data sheets.

QUESTION Nº 2.c: *Item 16 – Evaluation criteria of qualification (Lowest Total Evaluated Price)*

We kindly request clarification regarding the criterion of "Lowest Total Evaluated Price," particularly concerning its application in cases where the quotation is submitted on a partial basis and not for all the listed items

ANSWER N°. 2. c: Quotations that do not cover all items listed in the RFQ will not be considered. The "Lowest Total Evaluated Price" criterion applies only to quotations that cover all items, meet the qualification criteria, and are substantially responsive.

QUESTION Nº 3: Regarding the List of Goods, Related Services and Delivery Schedule

Considering that RFQ No. 014/HSP/UGPE does not allow the submission of variant quotations, and having verified, following market consultation, that the products listed below are not available in accordance with the requested specifications, thus making it impossible to submit a quotation strictly under the defined terms, we kindly request clarification, on an exceptional basis, as to whether technically equivalent alternatives may be considered, as presented in the table below, under the "Remarks" column.
